Dear Mr. Ghebreyesus,

I am writing on behalf of the members and partners of the Ministry of Health, located in America. The purpose of this letter is to place you and participating members on notice prior to the 75th Annual World Health Assembly, May 22-28th, 2022 in Geneva, Switzerland. I am informed that the following are intended agenda item for the upcoming assembly:

- Ratification of International Health Regulations (IHR) by participating members representing 194 member nations.
- Debate and discussion on amendments to IHR.
- Engagement on the Treaty on Pandemic Prevention and Preparedness.

Be advised that the Ministry of Health, its members and its partners have been established in the private domain with all protections afforded and guaranteed by the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR), the Constitution of the United States of America, the Constitution of the several States, the Canadian Charter of rights, and by law. In the private domain members of the Ministry of Health conduct all manner of ministry and any manner of business as seen fit by the Ministry founders, Trustees and partners.



I request that you cease facilitating any actions by the World Health Organization or any member States that results in infringing, knowingly or unknowingly, on the private domain of the members of the Ministry of Health and our partners. You are hereby advised to inform any and all participants in the upcoming 75th Annual World Health Assembly, May 22-28th, 2022 in Geneva, Switzerland, prior to any policy ratifications of the following:

- Any policy decisions are excluded from the private domain.
- The implementation limitations of any public policy decision made by participating members of the 75th Annual World Health Assembly.
- That all participating members of the upcoming 75th Annual World Health Assembly are hereby personally liable as a signatory for any resulting infringements upon the private domain or the sovereign rights of any member of the Ministry of Health or its partners. Liability extends to any authorizing body or nation state that recognizes the action of their representative.
- The Convention on the Privileges and Immunities of the Specialized Agencies is categorically rejected. It is objectively verifiable that participants legitimizing the IHR exceed the limitations of their vested authority set by pre-existing oaths of office *to secure the Blessings of Liberty to ourselves and our Posterity*. Health freedom and liberty is beyond the scope of said Convention; any privilege anticipated is thus null and void for all violators foreign and domestic.
- The primary duty of government within the U.S. is to secure and protect life, liberties, and property of the people of the U.S. Any treaty language that purports to extend any level of immunity to any person or entity who trespasses or infringes upon the liberties of the people of the U.S. can never be held to be valid language and is null and void ab initio. All attempts to subvert our protections of liberties will result in the trespassing person and/or entity being held liable for those attempts at trespass. No level of immunity may be extended by law.

All members of the Ministry of Health and its partners have the right to seek redress from any and all signatories to any ratified documents and resulting actions that infringes on privacy rights established under the UN Charter of human rights, Canadian Charter of Rights, Articles 1 & 14 of the United States Constitution, and our faith based convictions. Use of the IHR or a Treaty on Pandemic Prevention and Preparedness, or related documents, as the basis for any actions that breaches the private domain of the members of the Ministry of Health or our partners are advised to hereby cease and desist. Absent a prompt resolution to this matter, any infringement that is ratified is now the personal responsibility of the participating parties in the 75th Annual World Health Assembly. Our legal teams and membership are hereby authorized to take appropriate action to seek redress against any signing parties, representative bodies, and authorizing nation states infringing on the private domain as a result of actions taken at the 75th Annual World Health Assembly. Any further infringing activities occurring after the receipt of this letter shall be considered a willful infringement.
